altered|esthetics Art Vending Machine Artwork Guidelines

The mission of altered|esthetics art vending machine is to make affordable artwork, from local, national, and international artists accessible to everyone. altered|esthetics vending machine is also a great opportunity to help artists promote and expose their artwork to the public, while preserving the artist's voice in society.

Artists will also need to create a 2" x 2" placard to be placed in front of their slot in the vending machine. This placard will tell customers what they are buying and who made it. Please at least include name and the title of the series of artwork along with a brief description of the artwork. Our staff will be more than happy to create a placard for artists who would like the help.

altered|esthetics vending machine is accessible to buyers of all ages and artists should keep this in mind when creating their works. If artwork is not appropriate for all ages please label placard with Rated R or Small Parts-Not Suitable For Children. If there are any questions about potential hazards involved in the artwork, please contact tonytudisco@alteredesthetics.org.

Artwork and/or boxed artwork must conform to the dimensions: 2 1/8" x 3 1/4" x 7/8". If boxes are not used, artwork dimensions must be the same as the box dimensions. For example, an artist may paint on wood blocks or canvases that are the same dimensions as the box dimensions.

Because of the mission of the vending machine to make affordable original artwork available to everyone as well as help raise funds for altered|esthetics the artist can choose to split the funds received with altered|esthetics or choose to allow altered|esthetics to receive 100% of the profit from the sale of the artwork. Artwork will be vending for \$5.00.

Once accepted, altered|esthetics asks that artists produce between 10 and 20 pieces for use in altered|esthetics' vending machine. altered|esthetics is willing to supply wood blocks for artist who are donating 100% of the funds received to altered|esthetics. altered|esthetics also retains the right to change the price of artwork after 60 days in the vending machine. altered|esthetics retains the right to rotate stock of vending machine as they see fit.
